Joel's Sheet Music in Display Case



Monticello Village Clerk Joel Dutenhoefer has a collection of old sheet music which used to belong to his Aunt Virginia Browne. Joel's grandmother taught herself to play the piano, but she had no lessons so she saw to it that her daughters took piano lessons. Virginia was the one who excelled at the piano. She played piano in the school band back when school bands had pianos as a part of the band, but mostly she played at home.

Aunt Virginia played the piano her whole life and bought many copies of popular sheet music. Upon her death, the sheet music went to Joel's mother who turned it over to him since he has become the family historian. Joel has a huge bagful of all kinds of sheet music from the 20s, 30, and 40s. What he likes best about all of it is the artwork which is sometimes spectacular.

If you look closely at the display, you'll see some Irish sheet music and the Songs of Dennis Day which has an appropriate Green background for the month of March. The second shelf holds green sheet music to celebrate St. Patrick's Day. The first shelf holds oversized sheet music with some classics such as Peg O' My Heart and I'll Never Smile Again. The third shelf is decked out in orange and blacks and the bottom shelf has reds and pinks.

Joel's favorite cover portrays a beautiful young lady from the 20s in an orange turban against a blue background. The name of the song is My Castles in the Air Are Tumbling Down. Stop into the library & see how many you know.
