How does it work?

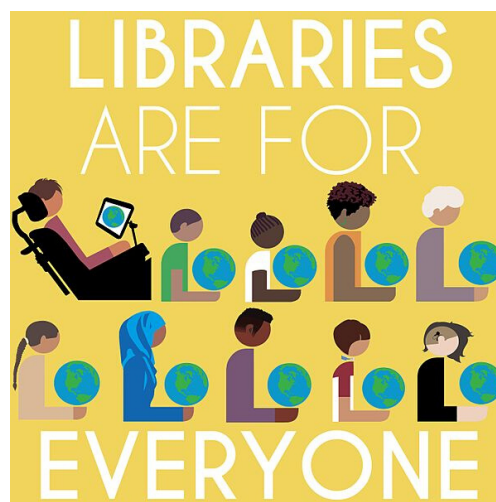
Well it's quite simple.
