Thanks, Roger!

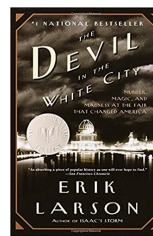
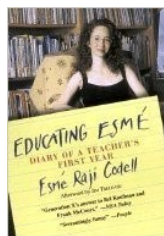
Historic Sites of Green County
